

Sam Schedler is a queer comedian working as a Registered Nurse in the Twin Cities of Minnesota. When off the clock, he takes to social media and provides a fresh perspective on hard-to-talk about topics like religious trauma, misinformation and LBGTQIA+ issues. Sam is passionate about making sure everyone in the room feels welcomed and valued.



TIQ MILAN JAN. 11, 2024

Tiq Milan speaks and writes about intersectional leadership, transgender rights, and racial justice. He shares stories of his life and how his transgender experience has informed his views on masculinity, race, and the gender binary. A journalist for over a decade, his work has appeared on MIC, Buzzfeed, NBC and CNN.



BREA BAKER FEB. 15, 2024

Brea Baker is a skilled communications strategist, influencer engagement professional, activist/organizer, and social impact advisor. She has contributed to dozens of electoral and advocacy campaigns including the 2017 Women's March (where she served as the youngest national organizer), the 2018 student walkouts against gun violence, Jumaane Williams' successful bid for NYC Public Advocate, and more.






